



The Brief

- We're looking for digital captures of up to 5 of your best artworks.
- Your work should be hand-drawn, painted, collaged or digitally rendered. Mixed mediums are great, but no photography please.
- Your art should tell a story, be intelligent, and show your creative individuality. Take a look at some of our other [wall art](#) for inspiration. We don't have a set aesthetic—but we do want to see yours.
- Images must be in .jpg or .png format at 1200x1200 px. You may submit up to 5 unique designs using the template provided.
- Your entire upload can not exceed 10MB! So, if you are uploading 5 designs, each image must be no larger than 2MB; if you are uploading 4, each image must be no larger than 2.5MB. You get the idea, right?

The Contest

UncommonGoods will select a number of entries to move to the semifinal round based on skill, style and originality. During the semifinal round, finalists will be added to the Voting Tool where the online community may vote for their favorite entries and leave comments. UncommonGoods will look at the number of positive votes, but will not take negative votes into account.

At the end of voting, UncommonGoods will select the top 5 vote-getting entries to be presented to a panel of judges. Judges will select one Grand Prize Winner who will be notified by May 11, 2012 and the winning entry will be announced on UncommonGoods.com.

The Grand Prize Winner will receive \$500 + the offer of a licensing agreement to reproduce their work as a limited edition of 100 prints. If the Grand Prize winner chooses not to accept the prize, an alternate Grand Prize winner will be chosen.

UncommonGoods reserves the right to offer a vendor agreement to other entrants in addition to the Grand Prize Winner.

Eligibility

- You must be a U.S. resident within the fifty states and District of Columbia and at least 18 years old.

- The entry period for the Competition ends at 11:59 p.m. EDT on April 26, 2012.
- Each design must be an original work and cannot include any copyrighted elements (no logos, slogans, or art in use).

General Conditions

By participating in the Challenge, entrants agree to abide by the terms of these Official Rules and by the decisions of the Company and the judges, which will be final and binding on all matters pertaining to this Challenge. You agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Company from and against all claims or damages arising out of the use of any design or other materials you submit.

By submitting an entry, you grant to Company and assign an unlimited, worldwide license to publish, display, use, edit, copy, disseminate, post, or otherwise use all or any portion of your entry materials online, in print, film, television, or in any other media for editorial, advertising, promotional, and other purposes without compensation or notification of any kind to you, except as prohibited by law, during the time frame of the challenge.

In such event, the prize will be awarded by judging from among eligible entries received up to the date/time of corruption or modification, to the extent feasible. Company is not responsible for late, lost, incomplete, or misdirected entries; computer system, equipment or program malfunctions, or other errors; failures or delays in computer transmissions or network connections; damage to entrant's or any other person's computer related to or resulting from participation; or for any other technical problems related to web site entries.
