



### Sedum Terrarium Bottle™

**how to grow.** **1.** Remove the 'chopsticks' from the belly wrap of the sedum terrarium bottle™. **2.** Open the terrarium bottle™ and take out the triangle seed pack, ribbon band (used for the 'chopstick' base) and the bag of recycled glass drainage pebbles with soil. **3.** Open up the drainage pebble section of the bag and pour it into the terrarium bottle and shake it gently to evenly distribute. **4.** Open the soil section of the bag and pour it into a small bowl. Using a spoon, scoop half the soil over the drainage pebbles distributing evenly. **5.** Open the seed pack and sprinkle over the remaining soil in the bowl. **6.** Mix the seed into the soil with a spoon and then scoop the soil and seed mix into the terrarium. **7.** Use a spray bottle to water. Direct the spray to the top and sides of the terrarium to create a gentle rain over the soil. The soil should remain damp like a sponge and be at 75°-85°F (24°-26°C) for proper germination. The seed should begin to germinate in 7-10 days. **8.** To create the base, put the ribbon loop around your 'chopsticks', place on a flat surface and spread the 'chopsticks' apart for your terrarium bottle™ to nest within. **9.** Place in a windowsill with morning (eastern) sun. **10.** After seedlings are established, small mementos can be added to create your own personalized miniature landscape.
